

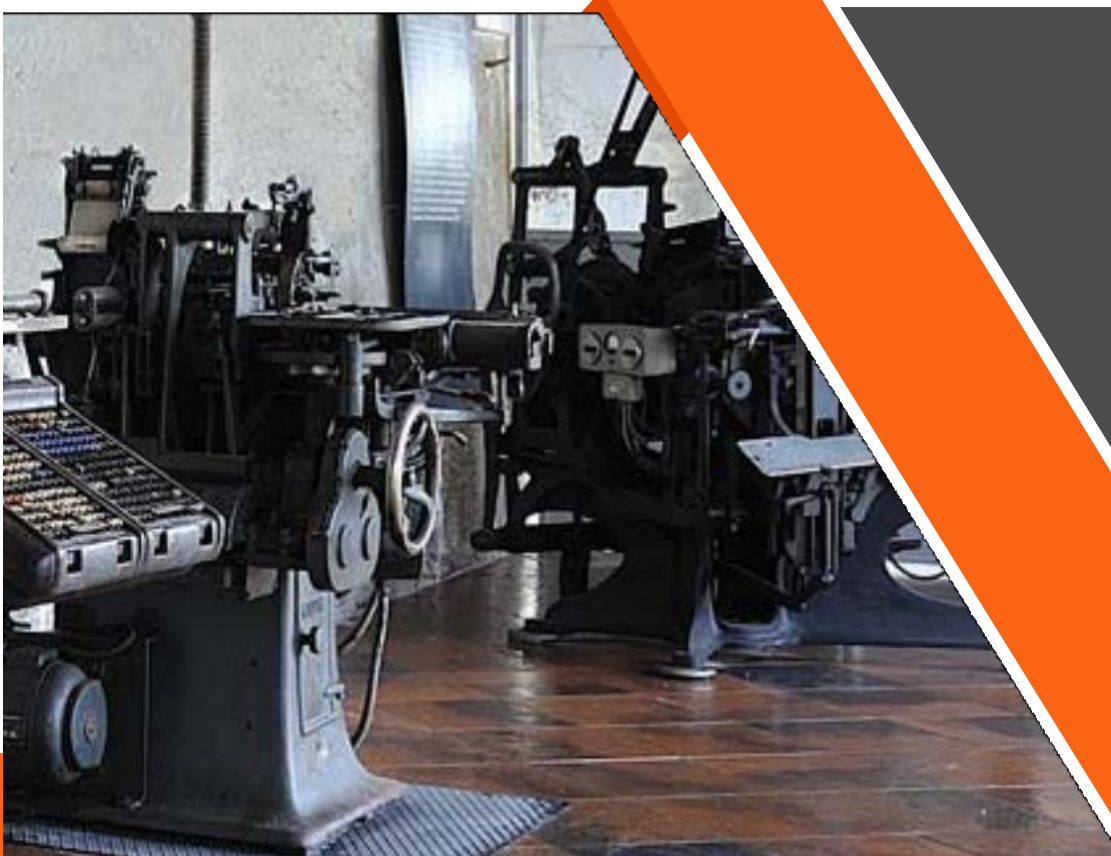

INTRODUCTION

Alternanza, a new “school/work” training programme

In partnership with Corte della Miniera, Museum Graphia offers new and innovative learning methods for acquiring knowledge and labor market skills to meet the school operation guidelines of the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research. Student-centric in situ learning to learn, Alternanza’s labs and working environments offer myriad opportunities to acquire real-world skills, consolidate those learned in school and acquire the culture of work through real-world experience.

Alternanza activity is programmed as a multi-year education plan with a strong integration and formative equivalence between the realities of schooling and the workplace. It should not be considered as an isolated experience within the continuum of curriculum-based learning; rather, here students gain hands-on experience to combine two distinct learning environments – school and work.

Alternanza is learning in action within the context of collaborative partnerships with schools, both locally and throughout Europe and indeed the world, to co-plan training courses that take place on the Corte della Miniera premises. These can be funded through the educational programming of Erasmus+. Projects have the educational value equivalent to the classroom curricula and/or work duties carried out during an internship in the labor market toward personalized learning and acquiring professional skills.

Our faculty consists of teachers and professionals in the industries represented in the training programme, able to provide formative and cumulative assessments of the learning taking place on site and in the field. Our facilities in Urbino contain ample space for engaging students in a variety of work experiences, and break down architectural barriers to accommodate students with disabilities.

Infrastructure - the availability of specialized equipment and technology-advanced processes for carrying out activities in compliance with current regulations on technical verification, testing and safety. Our facilities are thus transformed into living labs, a user-centered, iterative, open-innovation ecosystem to integrate innovative learning with work experience.

Professional Tutoring – our faculty work in close cooperation with the sending school’s staff and faculty to guarantee each student acquires adequate and hands-on experience of the work environment within the realm of art and printing (multi-media, lithography, screen-printing, etc.) as well as to overcome disabilities such as dysgraphia.

Training is also offered to capitalize on our expertise in agritourism and farm-to-table food production; culinary arts and gastronomy; components of the fashion industry regarding media and raw materials.



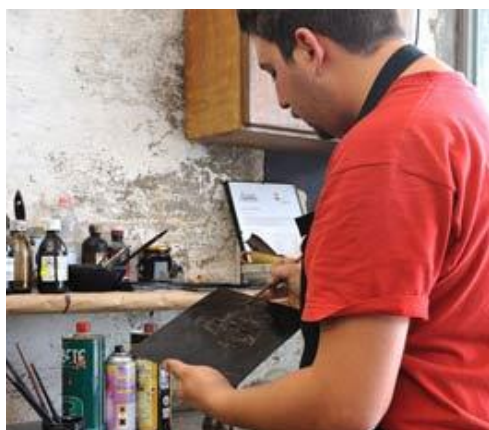

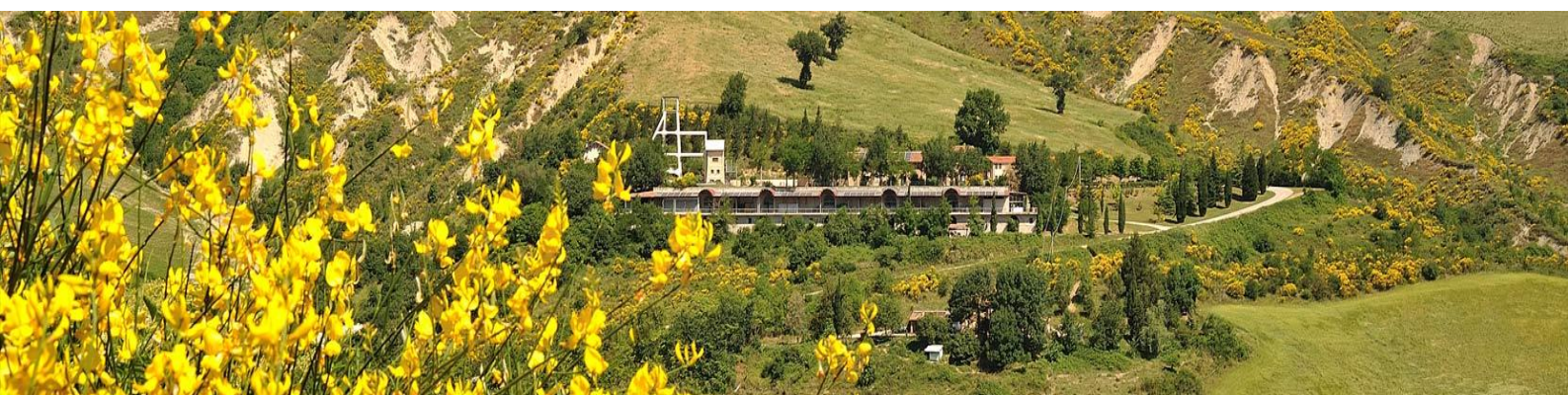

LOCATION
